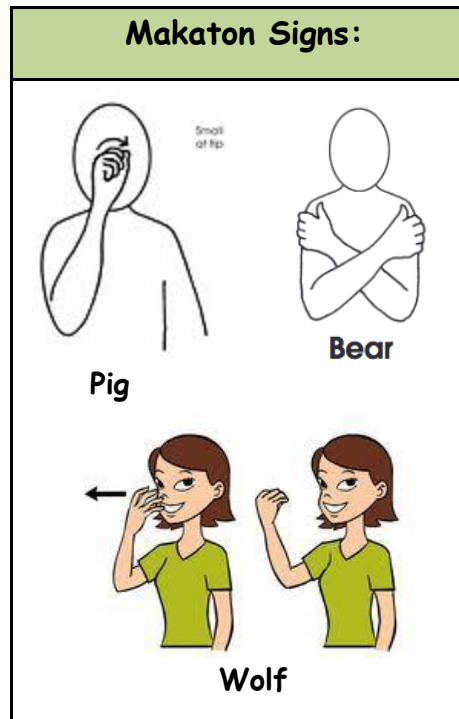
Key Vocabulary
